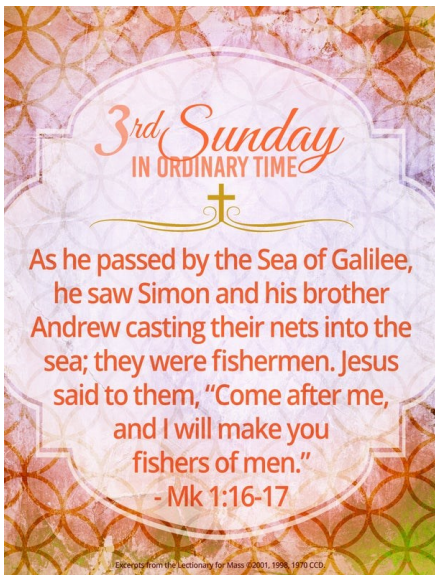
Today's Reflection: Everyday Stewardship
