WHY DO WE DO THAT?



CATHOLIC LIFE EXPLAINED

"Is it ever OK to leave Mass before it ends?"

The short answer is, "no," but we definitely want to go a bit deeper as we consider why.

First, when we must think about questions like this, we must consider this in adult terms. If there is something gravely important that we need to do, then we must attend to that. However, if it is a matter of convenience or preference, then we really have to stop and think again. First, while we always recognize the importance of sacramental communion in the Mass, we also need to understand how important the time of thanksgiving and prayer after communion is. We are also commissioned to "Go forth" during the Dismissal of the Mass, reminding us that we have been entrusted with a gift—the Word of God and the Presence of Christ in the sacrament—and that we are to share that gift with others.

If we simply leave after we receive communion, we risk two things. First, there is the possibility that we will turn our reception of communion into a purely personal, individual experience that is separated from our common experience of worship, and, second, we lose an opportunity for gratitude and serious reflection. This time of thanksgiving, reflection and, ultimately, missioning, are important and, in the end, an essential part of the celebration of the Mass.

Corpus Christi Parish
Financial Update
February 6 and 7, 2021

- The financial position of our parish has improved during the first half of this fiscal year.
 - Income has increased versus budget and versus the same period last year.
 - Expenses are lower than the same period last year, but a bit higher than budget due to timing, pandemic-related costs, and the costs associated with staffing reorganization (e.g., unemployment costs).
- So far this year, ordinary income has exceeded ordinary expenses by \$102,544, which is 12% favorable to budget. However, these results include generous one-time donations for Christmas, etc., as well as some prepaid tuition. *We expect full year results to be favorable, but closer to budget.*
- These great results are due to the generosity of our parishioners and the careful management of expenses by parish administration. THANK YOU!
