“Do We Become Angels When We Die?”

As human beings, we are both spiritual and corporeal. We are body and soul. This makes us unique in all creation. No other physical creature—plant or animal—possesses an immortal soul made in God’s image and likeness. Like the distinction with plants and animals, angels have an entirely different sort of existence. Angels are pure immortal spirit, and they have been so since the moment of their creation.
