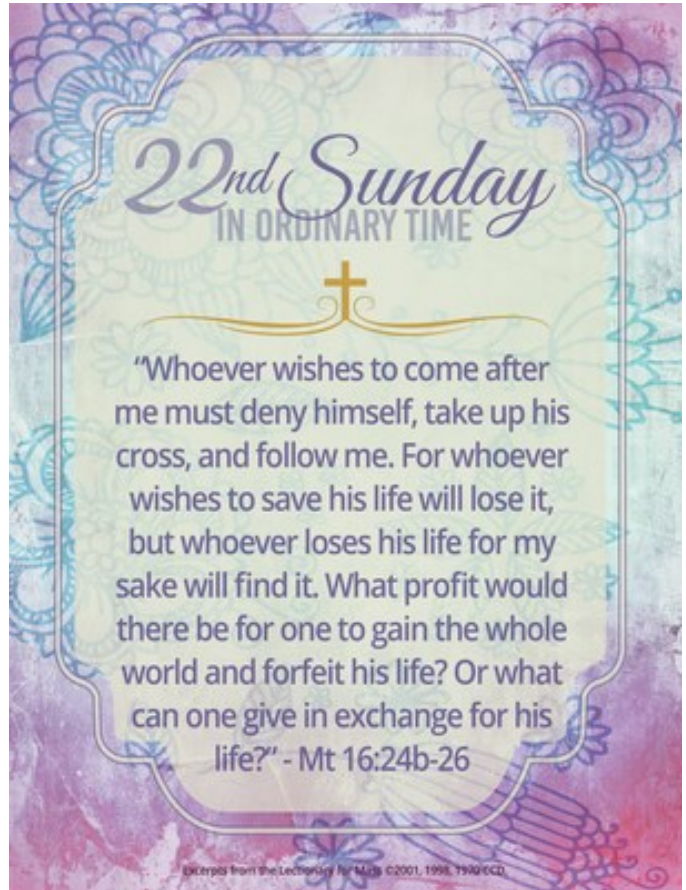

This past summer, a few of our seminarians put together articles about their experience of seminary, their vocation story, or reflections on the faith. Here is one from Nick Sellers, Holy Cross Parish:



"For the love of the game!" This is a quote that I always enjoyed. It made me question why I play various sports. The quote encompasses the idea that sports are more than mere selfish accomplishments, rather they are about the joy that comes from training and giving yourself to something or someone. I enjoy football and all the training because it is an opportunity to lay down my life in a way for others. That being said, I still struggled with prideful ambitions. It is both of these mentalities that I carried into the seminary.
