Dear Parishioners,

By the time you are reading this, Fr. Jerry and I will be nearing the end of our time walking in the places where Jesus lived, taught, healed, and prayed. We are looking forward to sharing these experiences with you back home as we try to continue living more fully as Jesus taught us to live as disciples and as priests.

This weekend's Masses are celebrated by a priest from Saint Meinrad. The "Holy Hill", as many call it, stands as a witness to more than a century and a half of Catholicism in southern Indiana. So many of our priests and laity have spent time at Saint Meinrad, and its influence has been one of profound depth and breadth since its founding in 1854. If you are able to support Saint Meinrad, I would encourage it. I make a donation to them every year. The work they do for priests, deacons, and all of us is tremendous.

Not to make this week's column all about stewardship, but we also need to take a look at our CPC standing. There has been some transition in personnel as St. Philip takes Carol Reising back exclusively to their staff (by the way, thank you, Carol, for both an incredible and tough job with both parishes for a long period of time), and as Judy Grannan helps out with parish finances while still working in bookkeeping at our school. Thanks for your patience and support as we change.

If you have energy and ideas, please step up. Our Church is the Body of Christ, and when all of the parts are working, we can do great things.
