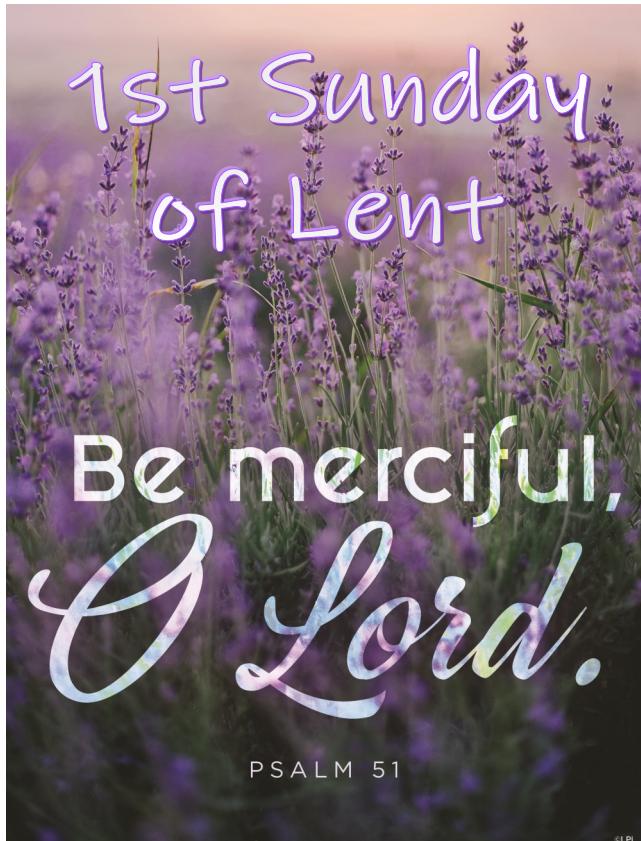

Dear Parishioners,

Seventy-five years ago, the Holy See carved out our 12 counties from the Archdiocese of Indianapolis to make the Diocese of Evansville. Ten years later, Corpus Christi parish was founded. As we celebrate our 75th anniversary, Bishop Siegel asked the Holy See to grant a plenary indulgence to any member of the faithful who visits one of four designated churches during this anniversary year and who also fulfills the instructions for receiving an indulgence. Here are the details:

Four pilgrimage churches have been selected: St. Benedict Cathedral, St. James in Haubstadt, St. Joseph in Jasper, and St. Francis Xavier Minor Basilica in Vincennes. Those who visit any one of these churches for personal prayer, for Confession, or for Mass have completed the third of the five steps:

1. Sacramental Confession (within 20 days of the church visit)
2. Have the interior disposition of complete detachment from sin, even venial sin
3. Visit one of the pilgrimage churches recognized by the Holy See
4. Pray for the intentions of the Supreme Pontiff (typically an Our Father, Hail Mary, and Glory Be)
5. Receive the Holy Eucharist (it is certainly better to receive it while participating in Holy Mass, but for the indulgence, only Holy Communion is required)

This "plenary indulgence" is offered so that we can be relieved of the suffering our sins have caused us. In other words, while a penance fulfilled after a normal Confession helps heal our hearts, this larger penance of the steps for the indulgence remits *all* of the temporal punishment. It heals you, and you are fully open to the grace of God. An indulgence can also be offered up from you for someone (like a family member) who has died.

Each of us are allowed to take advantage of these plenary indulgences throughout this anniversary year. I encourage our families to try to do this at least once during Lent. You would be amazed at the effect it will have in your hearts and on your home. Perhaps your family can make it a goal to get to all four churches and receive four plenary indulgences by November of this year.

Happy anniversary, and a blessed beginning of Lent.
