Dear Parishioners,

In this new arrangement linking our parish to Resurrection under the leadership of Fr Jerry, there are many things in transition. Father Jerry is a good leader and priest. I am excited to be working with him. Thank you on his behalf (and mine) for your patience.

As I am able, I hope to be sharing things with you in the bulletin each week. This week, there are three things:
 First, Mark Robinson, the lifetime husband of our middle school teacher Laura Robinson, died about a week ago. I had his funeral here, and the sixth, seventh, and eighth grades were able to attend. Mrs. Marty Craig was able to find principles and administrators of local Catholic schools to cover all classes so that all teachers could be present to pray with Mrs. Robinson. With a children's choir singing, and so many from our school community surrounding Laura and her family, it was among the most powerful and beautiful funerals I've been to. We have quite a school!

Second, to follow up on Fr. Jerry's homily last weekend about making our faith our own prerogative, there are two opportunities for adults to live that message out! "Welcome Weekends" are being hosted at Corpus Christi on Feb 29 (Men's) and March 7 (Women's). You should consider going. Also, the Men and Women's "Cursillo" weekends are on February 20 (Men's) and March 26 (Women's) at the Sarto Retreat Center. I have been on several myself, and there is no better faith formation for an adult Catholic in our diocese than attending a Cursillo. Give it to your spouse, your family, yourself, or as a gift to the Lord. You won't regret it. It'll change your life.

Finally, before Fr. Jerry and I were linked up for parish ministries, he and I had already planned to travel together to Israel on pilgrimage this month. So, you will not see him or me from February 10-20. I had already set these dates before discovering that some of our parishioners will be heading to the Holy Land, as well. I hope that group also has a wonderful pilgrimage.
