## WHY DO WE DO THAT?

Catholic Life Explained:

**Why do Priests Kiss the Altar at Mass?**

Our churches and chapels are filled with symbols. Some of these might be forgotten, as they seem to be just part of the building, including the lectern, the priest's chair and the altar. The altar holds a special place. It is the place "on which the Sacrifice of the Cross is made present under sacramental signs and is the table of the Lord to which the People of God are called together to participate in the Mass, as well as the center of the thanksgiving that comes throughout the Eucharist\*." \*-General Instruction of the Roman Missal"

We recognize the importance of the altar when the priest and deacon kiss the altar. Doing this is an act of devotion. Remember that we also kiss the cross on Good Friday, and the "Book of the Gospels" is kissed after the Gospel is proclaimed.
