

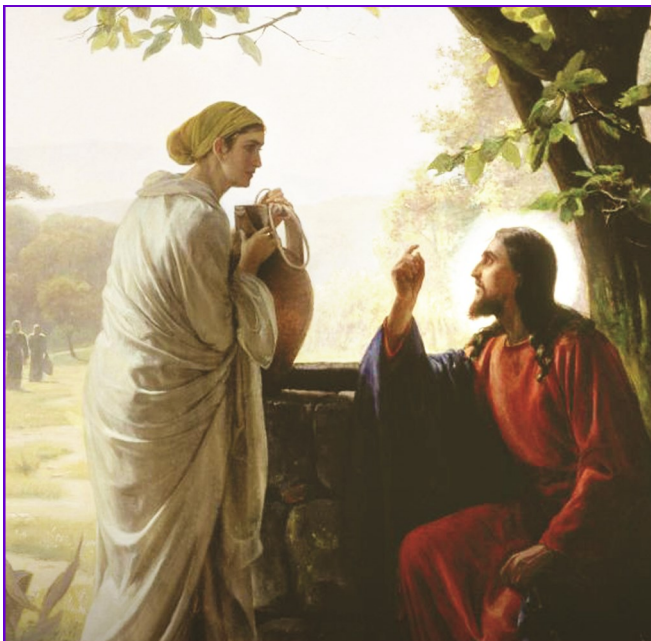

Dear Parishioners,

As some have noticed, we are trying out a few things in the church to see whether they might work better.

First, **Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion** will proceed to the sacristy during the Lamb of God. This will give them time to wash their hands and be closer to the altar for receiving Communion and helping to distribute. It seemed awkward to have them wait in their pews. This should be smoother and will allow for hand-washing during this season of many sicknesses.

The **chairs in the sanctuary** have also moved. The **Lectors** will now sit in the front pew rather than in the sanctuary, and the **Server** who holds the Missal will sit where the lectors used to be. That will get the server closer to the priest for holding the book at the beginning and end of Mass. The Lectors will actually be a little closer to the ambo and won't have to walk from the side to the middle back to the side when they move about the sanctuary. The **deacon and presider chairs** are also now closer to the altar and middle of the church building itself, and the **baptismal font** will be up on the riser to give it a more proper focus for welcoming the new members of our parish.

Since there is space to the sides of the altar, we moved the **processional candles** there. The **servers** will bring them in for Mass.

We are also working on getting a space in the church for **Funeral Showings**. Right now, the school entry is used, and this disrupts the schedule at school – which is our most important ministry. So, we are looking to relocate the spot for a casket in the side hall where the **votive candles** and **Holy Water** are currently located. This would allow a good flow of traffic for lining up to visit, and it also allows the school to remain in normal routines on days we have a funeral. We are looking for a new home in our church for the **Infant of Prague Statue, Candles, and Holy Water**. If you have an idea on this, I would welcome hearing it. We want to make the best thing work.

Finally, the **Men's Club** is funding the purchase of **new microphones** for the priest and deacon. The only one we currently have is held together with some tape and a bread-tie (*seriously*). Plus, not only is it important to be able to hear the priest at Mass, Deacon Tom does so much around this place. He deserves to be heard well on Sundays, too. *Thank you to the men of our parish for making this happen!*

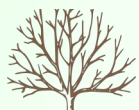
