

Dear Parishioners,

We are officially under a “shelter in place” order from the governor of Indiana. We have been asked that unless we are in serious need, we ought to stay in place until April 7. I hope you are able to heed this directive. If we all work together (by staying apart a short while), it sounds like gains can be made against the virus, and people will be saved from sickness and potential death.

**Thank You** to everyone who signed up for direct debit and who dropped off their envelopes this weekend. Our collection only dropped about 25% from the previous weekend. Some other parishes saw a drop of 50%. Thank you for your generosity!

I had been to and from our campus before the March 25–April 7 directive. I was struck at how many people from the parish had stopped by and asked me or another person on staff how they can help. “Can I pick up medications for someone?” “Is there any filing or paperwork I can help with?” “Does someone need me to get their groceries?” **What a kind and Christian place this is!** Thank you for those who have done what they can to follow the command of Jesus Christ to **love our neighbor** during this stressful and challenging time.

If you would like to find a way to help our parish during this quarantine, here are three ways:

First, **help us promote our Corpus Christi Catholic Church and Corpus Christi School Facebook pages.** These two pages are some of the best (and germ-free) ways we can still connect and interact. If you haven’t already “liked” and “shared” those two pages, please do! It will help bring a sense of community while we must be apart.

Second, **email Kim** (kgreulich@evdio.org) if you haven’t received any emails from the parish recently. Our email database is disproportionately low compared with our mailing list, and with things changing so quickly, email is the best way for us to communicate with everyone.

Finally, **make your home a place of prayer.** Honestly, I think this is *the single most important thing* we, as the Body of Christ, can do right now. Order a painting of a Saint on delivery from Amazon. Put a crucifix in a special room or corner of a room where you or your children can stop by for a second to say a quick prayer. Put pillows on the ground to kneel upon, and light a candle. You’ll be amazed at what happens to your soul when you “sanctify your day” by even the shortest prayer at morning, midday, evening and night. And if you haven’t joined your children or spouse for a bedtime prayer in a while, tell them, “Fr Tyler said we have to do this.” Yes, blame me. I can take it. And simply then list two things you want the Lord God to hear, like, “Keep my mother healthy” or “Help me find peace right now”. Follow those two ‘petitions’ with an Our Father, Hail Mary, and Glory Be. It’ll change your family. It’ll change your soul. And slowly, it’ll make a small change in the world.


