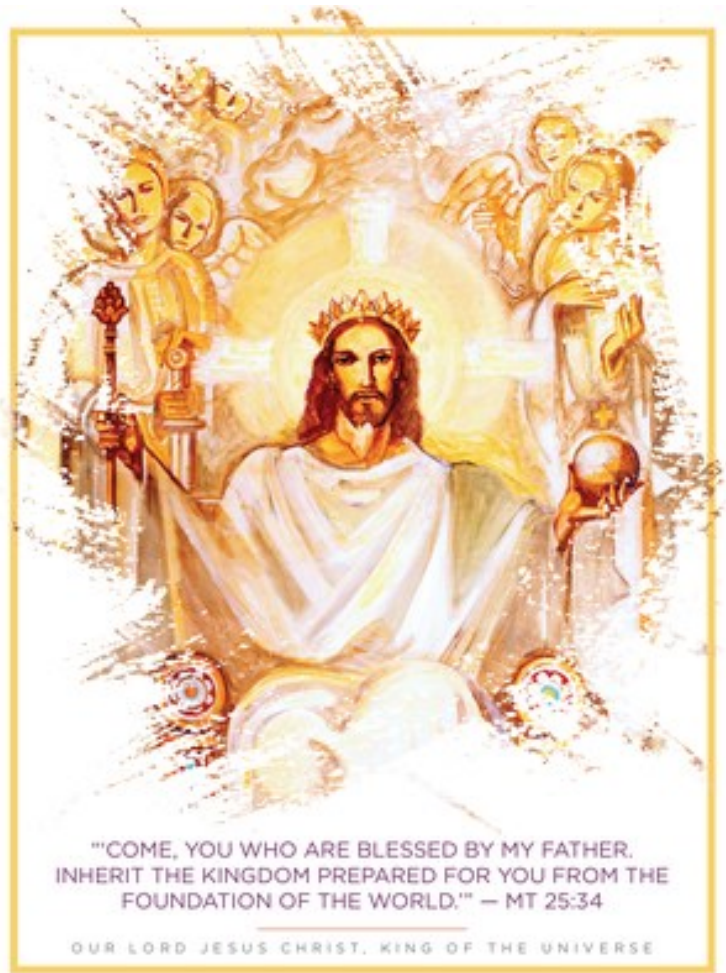

CATHOLIC LIFE EXPLAINED

"What is Eucharistic Adoration?"

The practice of Eucharistic Adoration is centuries old and falls within a broader category of devotion and rituals, associated with the Sacrament of the Eucharist. It is an extension of the worship and adoration of the Blessed Sacrament that occurs in every Mass.

In a long-standing practice, a period of Eucharistic Adoration often ends with "benediction," the blessing of the faith with the Blessed Sacrament.

Although adoration of the Blessed Sacrament can never take the place of Eucharistic Communion, many Catholics find great comfort and consolation in praying before the Eucharist, as it is exposed in the monstrance.

You are invited to join us at Corpus Christi every Tuesday at 6pm for our own Adoration and Benediction.
