CORPUS CHRISTI SCHOOL RECEIVES CULTURE OF EXCELLENCE GRANT

On January 4, 2018 at the Diocese of Evansville Catholic Center, the Koch Foundation announced that Corpus Christi Catholic School is the recipient of a Culture of Excellence Grant. The grants are to provide an opportunity for the parish school to permanently raise the levels of excellence in the spiritual, academic, social and physical education of their students to prepare them to assume leadership roles in their chosen fields based on Catholic values. The grant is for a three-year period and will begin in July 2018.

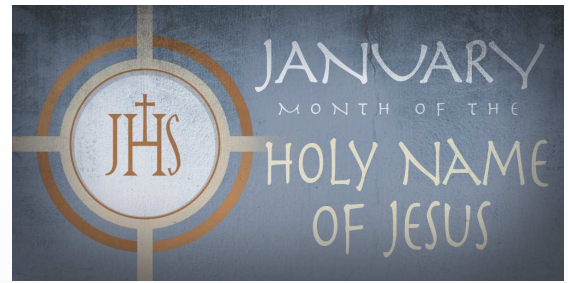
